GSITI welcomes the UPSC- 2008 Geologist's Examination batch officers appointed by GSI.

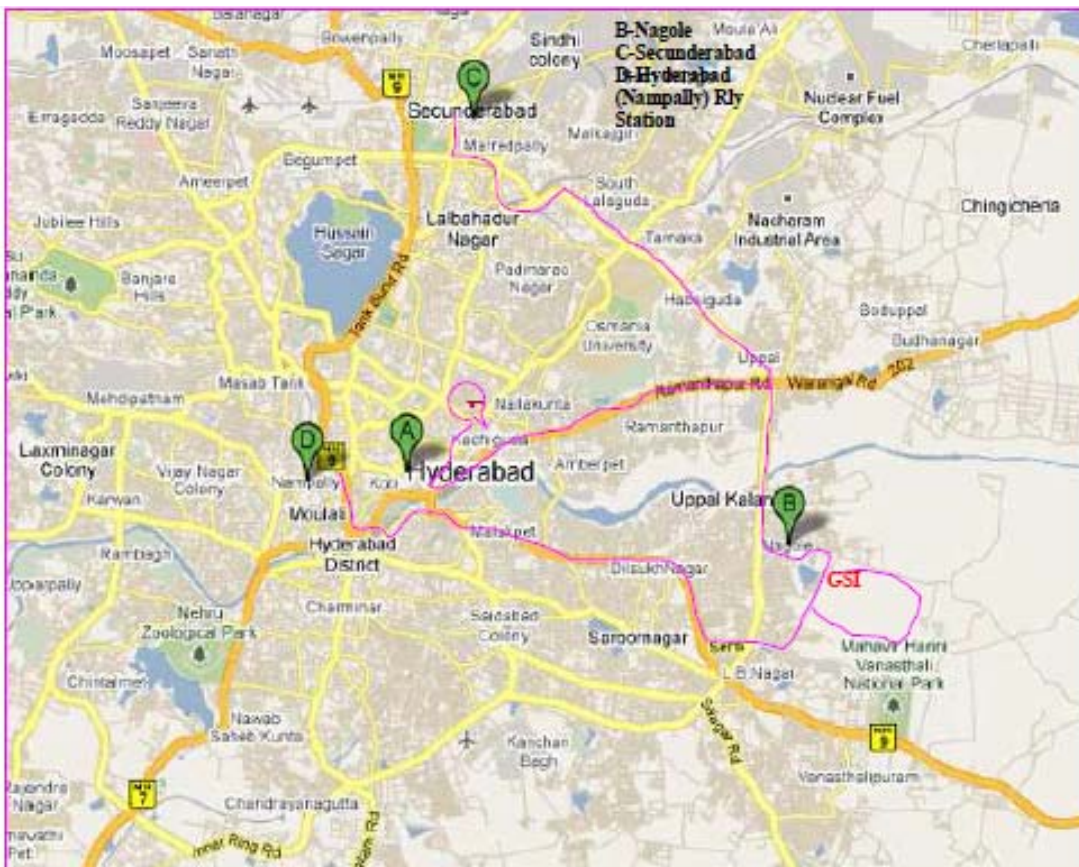
1. What if you have not received the provisional appointment letter?

Bring proof of identification like UPSC hall ticket, interview, mark sheet, offer letter, etc.

2. What documents to bring with you?

Nine Passport size photographs; Two Stamp size photographs; original certificates of date of birth, caste, education, UPSC selection letter with photocopies, proof of identification marks. The documents required at the time of joining will be sent to the individual officers by CHQ, GSI, and Kolkata which are to be duly filled and submitted. The same forms are also uploaded in portal for the benefit of the officers.

3. How to reach GSI training Institute in Hyderabad?



GSI Complex is located at Bandlaguda nearly 4 km from Nagole on the Uppal-L.B. Nagar Sector of the inner ring road. Nearest land mark is Kamineni hospitals. Autos and buses are available. Ask for GSI. Bus No's: From Secunderabad Rly.Station – 18G, From Nampally/Hyderabad Rly. Station and Koti womens college bus terminus-156G, 127, 100G, 1D/100G (Between 08.30 hrs to 10.00 hrs)

4. About accommodation facilities available in GSI, Hyderabad.

Accommodation will be made available on sharing basis in the GSI Campus.

5. Programme on the first day

The trainees on arrival at GSI TI should contact the volunteers available at the “S. Narayanaswamy Auditorium”. The trainees have to identify themselves either with the appointment letters, UPSC interview call letters or their examination hall ticket. The trainees identity will be established with the dossiers provided by the CHQ. The duly filled in documents and the original certificates (for eg. Qualification, date of birth and caste) will be verified by the administration. Joining formalities will be completed by 05.10.2010.

6.Training schedule

The 34th Orientation Course for Geologists will start on 06-10-2010 at 10.30hrs.

The training programme at Hyderabad, (Foundation module) starts on 06-10-2010 and ends on 17-10-2010. In the Foundation module, (1)know your organization & service rules, (2) human resources development and (3) certain basic geological principles are covered. The trainees disperse from Hyderabad to reassemble at various Field Training Centres on 19-10-2010. The training in various field centres will end on 31.03.2011.

After completion of the training, the trainees have to complete project work of one month duration and report back to the training institute for finale viva voce, examination and for end of the course ceremony. The total duration of this will be two months. The officers will be ready to take up their assignments in their new place of postings from 1st June 2011 onwards.

7. Precautions to be taken while on training

The trainee officers have to travel extensively and live under demanding circumstances and situations. They are accommodated in hutments and tents depending on the situation in the field training centers. The trainees have to take precaution about their health. Better if they

carry a mosquito net, personal medical kit. The period that they are with the TI spreads from October to May. This is period when the weather changes from Winter to Summer.

Appropriate clothing befitting the weather and field shoes are to be brought.

8. What is not permitted while on training?

The trainees are not allowed to bring their families to the training centers. No kind of leave will be granted / sanctioned during the period of training under normal circumstances.
